



## **Dogs on Club Premises**

Emsworth Sailing Club acknowledges that for some members having a dog is an integral part of their enjoyment of an active outdoor lifestyle and would like to support this, whilst also respecting that not all members will be comfortable having dogs in the Club setting.

Dogs will therefore be allowed on Club premises in accordance with the following:

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and under the control of an adult member. At no time must dogs be left unattended.
- Dogs are allowed in any of the the outside areas of the Club except for the benches immediately in front of Club and on the upper deck. Outside of British Summer Time (BST) dogs will be allowed in the area of the benches immediately in front of the Club.
- In the interest of safety and the amenity of other members, dog owners are strongly advised to consider the necessity of having a dog on Club premises during sailing and training events (typically 3 hours either side of high water).
- Members will be responsible for clearing any fouling left by their dog and any residue should be hosed or rinsed with fresh water.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their dogs at all times and must ensure that they do not display aggressive or anti-social behaviour, foul on main walkways or cause damage or fouling to other members' property. The General Committee may withdraw the right of any member to bring a dog onto Club premises if, in the opinion of the committee, they are not adhering to these rules.
