



Dogs on Club Premises

Emsworth Sailing Club acknowledges that for some members having a dog is an integral part of their enjoyment of an active outdoor lifestyle and as such would like to support this whilst also respecting that not all members may be comfortable with dogs being in the Club setting.

Dogs may be allowed on the Club premises subject to the following restrictions:

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and under the control of an adult member. At no time must a dog be left unattended.
- Dogs are only allowed in the outside areas of the Club premises and if seated only the picnic benches may be used. Dogs are not permitted on the terrace in front of the Clubhouse or on the upper deck.
- In the interest of safety and the enjoyment of the core activities of the Club, members are strongly advised to consider the necessity of having a dog on Club premises at peak times and particularly during sailing and training events (typically 3 hours either side of high water).
- Members will be responsible for clearing any fouling left by their dog and any residue hosed or rinsed with fresh water.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their dog at all times and must ensure that it does not display aggressive or anti-social behaviour, foul on main walkways or cause damage or fouling to other members' property.
- The General Committee may withdraw the right of any member to bring a dog onto Club premises whom, in the opinion of the Committee, is not adhering to these rules.
